Competitive Examination Study Circle (CESC)

25th August 2023

Adarsh Vidya Prasarak Sanstha's Adarsh college of Arts and Commerce in association with Unique Academy, Pune (Branch: Kalyan) had organized a seminar on 'Preparation for Competitive Examination- like UPSC, MPSC, SSC) on 24th August 2023 at 10.30 a.m. Venue- College Auditorium'.

The seminar was presided over by Dr. Sangeeta Pande (I/c Principal, Adarsh College of Arts and Commerce)

This seminar was conducted with a view:

- To create awareness amongst the undergraduate students regarding various opportunities in the Government sector- both central as well as state government.
- To guide the students about the techniques of preparation for competitive exams
- To answer the queries that the students might have through a post seminar interactive session.

Approximately 150 students of the college attended the seminar along with a few delegates from CHM College.

Mr. L. M. Satpute (Librarian- Adarsh College of Arts and Commerce presented the introductory speech followed by Mr. Sachin Rokade, who guided the students about the current scenario and opportunities available in the job market after graduation.

The Chief Speaker, Mr. Akash Manhore from Unique Academy thereafter explained the students about the eligibility criteria of various competitive examinations conducted by central government and state government comprising of UPSC, MPSC, CDS, SSC, NDA. (The eligibility criteria consists of age limit, qualifications required and any other requisite skills). He also shed certain light upon the salary and incentive scheme received by Government employees (both monetary as well as non-monetary).

The main focus point of his speech was:

- The syllabi, examination pattern and marking system of each of the above mentioned competitive exams.
- Do's and don'ts of preparations regarding competitive examinations.

Mr. Manhore, through his expert knowledge and exemplary oration was able to lift the fog of confusion which is there in the minds of undergraduates about 'what to do after graduation'?

His speech was followed by an interactive session with the audience where he answered the queries and doubts of few students from the audience.

Thereafter, Mr. Rishikesh Bhise (CRPF, Sub- Inspector, 2023) who was invited as Chief Guest for this seminar, was felicitated by Dr. Sangeeta Pande.
